Dear Colleagues:

I am pleased to present this Deans Report on the University of South Carolina's Sponsored Awards Activity for FY2006.

During this period, our faculty attracted \$173.3 million in funding from external sponsors in support of research, public service, and training projects. This 4.3 percent increase over last year's \$166.2 million total continues four consecutive years of growth and validates the Carnegie Foundation's designation of USC as an institution with "very high research activity." Only 62 public and 32 private research institutions in the United States share this ranking that firmly establishes USC among the nation's top research universities.

Going forward, it will not be easy for us to continue to break extramural funding records. The future—beyond an inauspicious federal funding climate—holds many fine institutions with which we compete for a slice of the funding pie. Even so, our faculty fundamentals are strong. The Centenary Plan is increasing the breadth and depth of our research faculty. And, we are learning to work smarter and harder in our focus areas while leveraging enhanced administrative support from SAM staff and systems—including the ongoing development of USCeRA, which recently added a searchable database of faculty CV's to facilitate collaborative research through immediate access to scholarly interests and equipment resources, and the GRANT program, which is upgrading the skills of research support staff centrally and in colleges, departments, and research centers.

Sponsored Award Activity for FY2006

Introduction

The Office of Sponsored Awards Management (SAM) is responsible for assisting the University community with externally funded research and other related initiatives. SAM's mission is to help faculty and staff identify and obtain funding for research and other sponsored projects from a variety of sources including government agencies, non-profit organizations, and private enterprises. The office serves as the central administrator for the submission of proposals as the overall manager of grants and contracts for USC and the USC Research Foundation.

This report provides an overview of proposals and awards handled by SAM for the Fiscal Year ended June 30, 2006.

Award Activity by College

The University of South Carolina achieved a record high in extramural funding to support its research, public service, and training projects during the past fiscal year. The total funding, \$173.3 million, represents 4% increase over the previous year's total of \$166.2 million.

The ten year annual increase of 125% represents a strong, sustainable growth rate.

Proposal Submissions by College

During the year, faculty submitted 1639 proposals requesting \$242.1 million. This is a decrease of \$11.1 million dollars over previous year's requested dollars. The number of submissions increased over previous year's 1639 vs 1609.

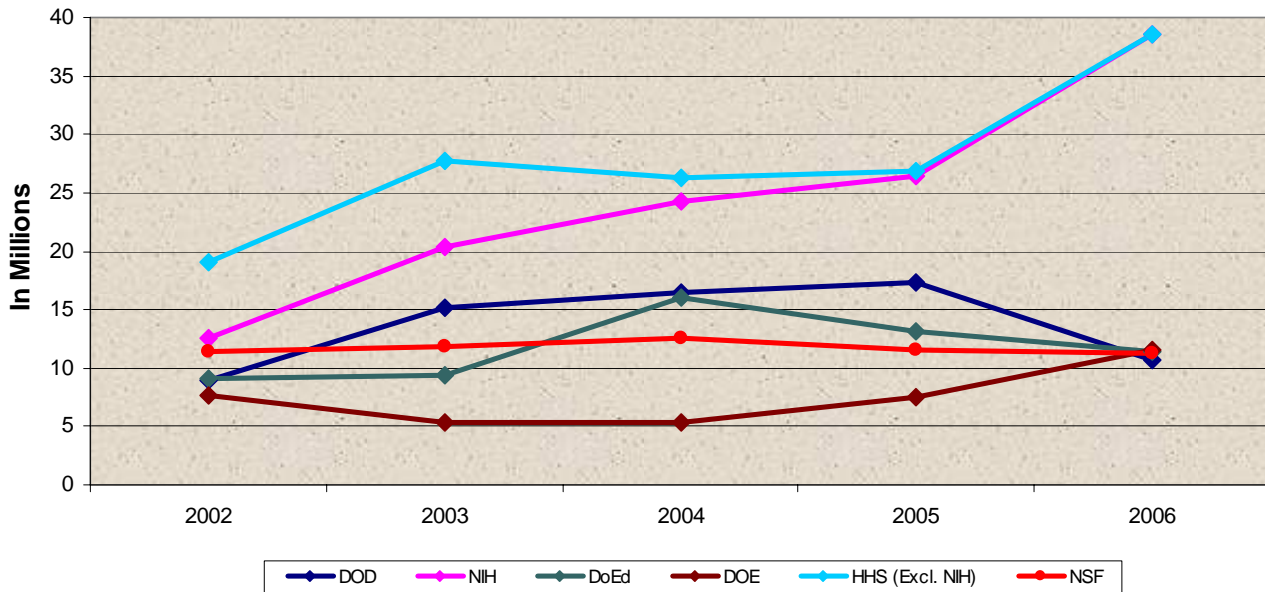
