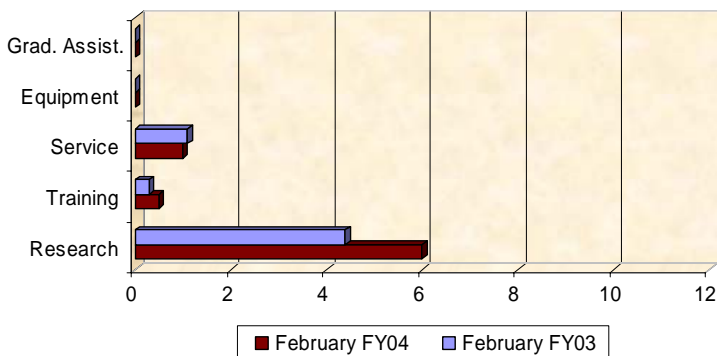

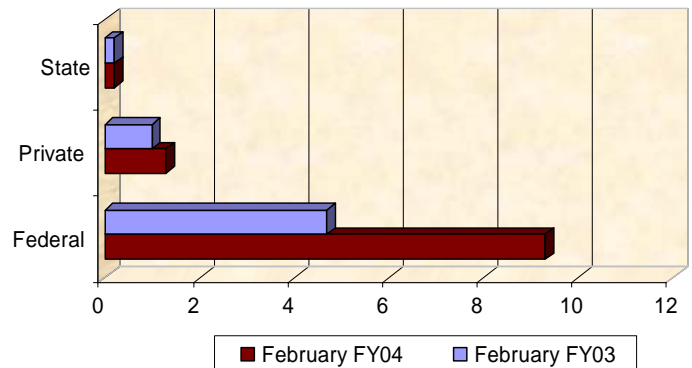
COMPARISON OF AMOUNT RECEIVED

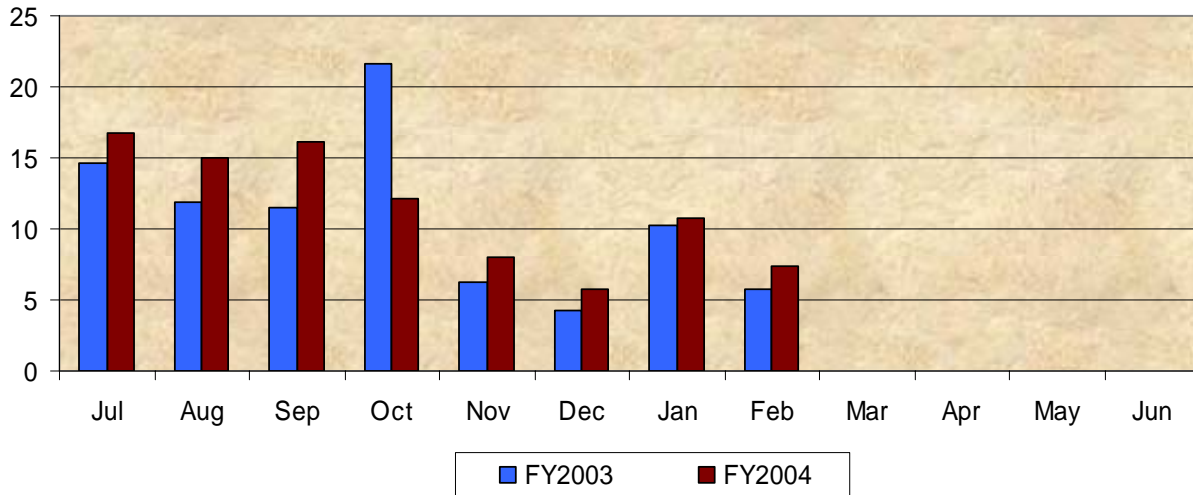

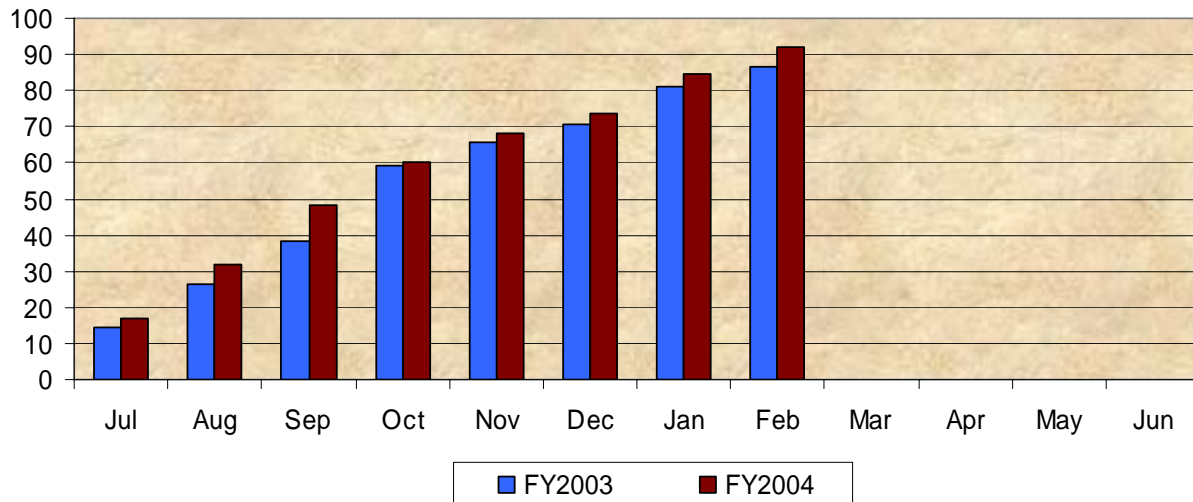
