RE: Report of Sponsored Program Activity for March 2003

Date: April 11, 2003

The University faculty, staff and students continue their aggressive pursuit of external funding for their scholarly activities. At the end of third quarter of FY2003, award dollars are twenty-five (25%) ahead of last year's pace.

- March 2003 awards totaled \$15.1 million of new funding, an increase of \$2.9 million from March 2002.
- Total awards (research, service, training) through March reached \$100.6 million (compared to \$80.7 million in FY2002), an increase of twenty-five (25%) when compared to last year's number.
- Faculty submitted 103 proposals requesting \$18 million during March. Thus far in the fiscal year, SPAR has processed 1209 proposals requesting \$164 million, compared to last year's totals of 1120 and \$123 million.

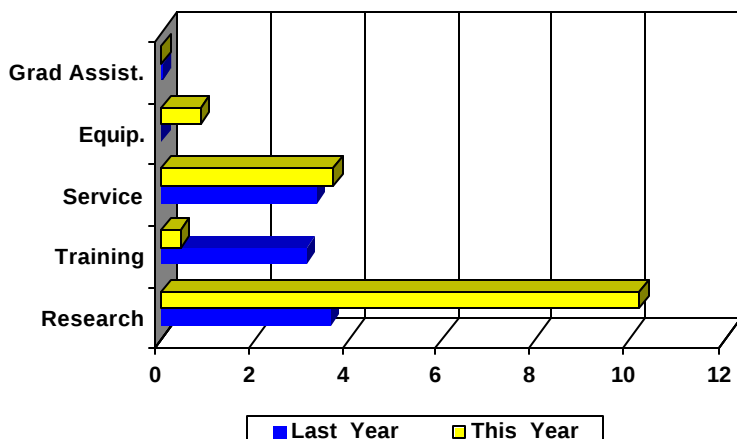

MARCH - 2003 vs. MARCH - 2002

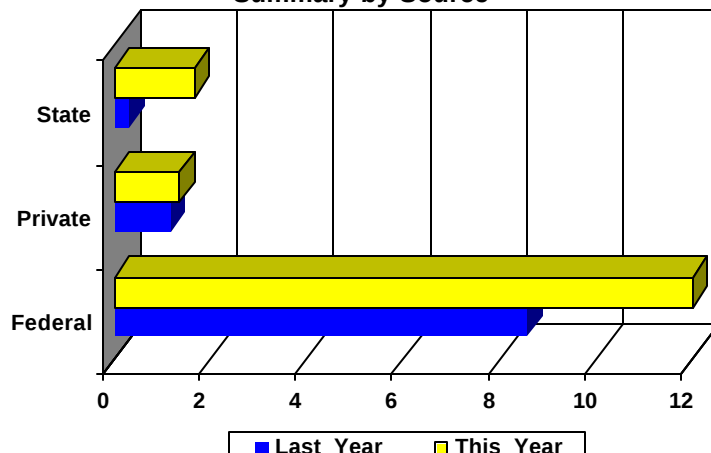
Amounts Received

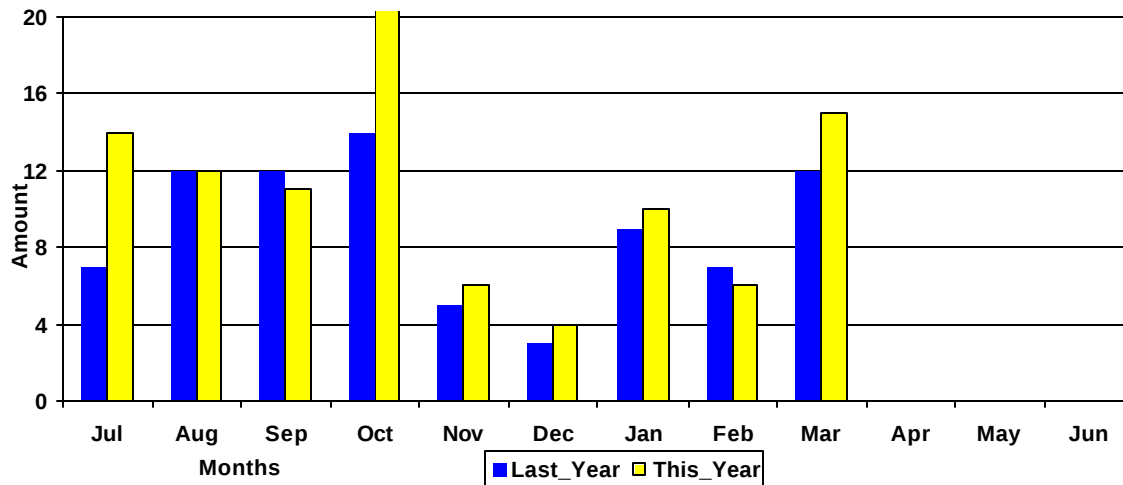

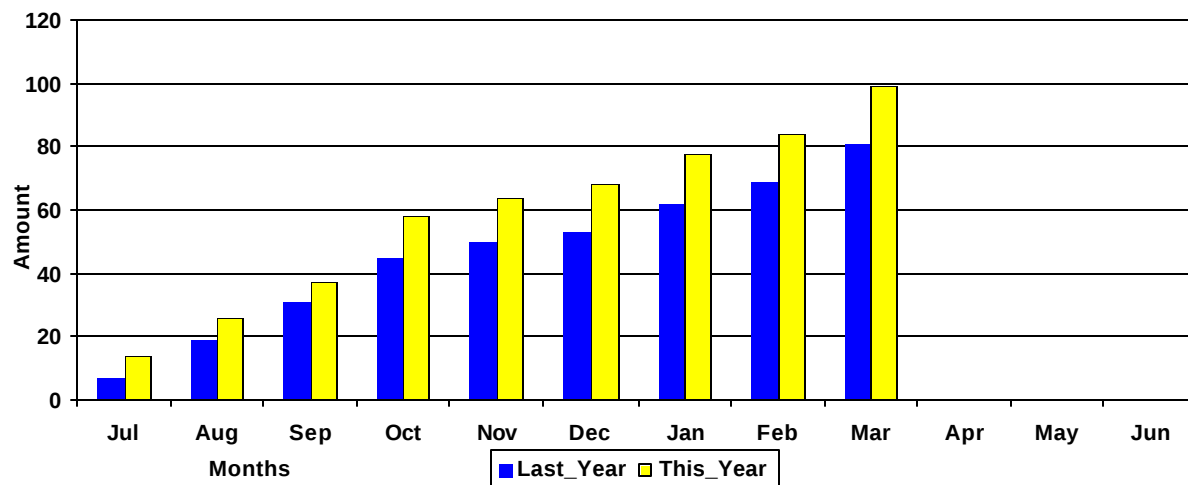
